Amateur radio license examinations set

Examinations to earn a new or upgraded Amateur Radio "Ham" License from the Federal Communications Commission will begin at 1 p. m. Saturday, June 14, at the LEMA/911 building, in Meridian.

The Meridian Amateur Radio Club sponsors the exams, but any qualified candidate is invited to take the test. The LEMA/911 (Lauderdale Emergency Management) building is located at 2525 14th St., in Meridian, across from the fire station.

The cost is \$14 for the test, payable by check or money order to ARRL VE. Preregistration is not required, but applicants must complete FCC Form 605 when they arrive and must bring some documents with them. Those include two forms of accepted identification, one of which is a photo I. D., as well as the original copy of any ham radio license currently held and any Certificate of Successful Completion of Examination from a previous exam. Use of cell phones and programmable calculators (unless it can be demonstrated that the calculator's memory has been cleared) are not allowed during the exam.
